Responsibilities of these positions will include:

1. Head Coach of the ABA Men's/Women's team and the role of overseeing the Men's/Women's Senior Representative Programme
2. The provision of input into the development of all HKBA junior representative programmes ensuring the Association has a strong pathway through to the ABA team.
3. Any other duty and/or responsibility the Board deems relevant to this role.

REPRESENTATIVE DEVELOPMENT OFFICER

3. Take responsibility for the ongoing education of junior representative coaches
4. Set points of emphasis for each season

5. Design the programmes for all representative camps
6. Attend junior representative training sessions and assist during representative games.
7. Any other duty and/or responsibility the Board deems relevant to this role.

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DEVELOPMENT OFFICER

Responsibilities of this position will include:

3. Assisting club coaches wherever possible to be better equipped to coach their team both in terms of competition and individual skill development.
4. Organising the running of Level 0 and Level 1 courses each year.
5. Conducting skills classes for local competition players throughout each school term.
6. Overseeing the conduct of holiday camps for local competition players.
