

Basketball NSW is calling for applications for the Basketball Australia National Intensive Training Centre Program (NITCP) Coaching Network.

Aim

The aim of Basketball Australia's National Intensive Training Centre Program (ITCP) is to identify and select outstanding basketball athletes, aged between 14-17 years, to a NITCP Squad, and develop their mental skills, individual skills and team concepts which will enable them to compete successfully at National and International level. Selection to an NITCP Squad is for a 12-month period.

The Program is under the direction of the NSW NITCP Head Coach. The NITCP operates throughout Country & Metropolitan NSW.

Being a high performance based program opportunities exist for coaches to progress within the Basketball NSW Development System to positions of greater responsibility such as State Head or Assistant Coaches

NITCP Network Coaches may have various responsibilities ranging from attending camps and any scheduled ITCP events, to conducting individual training sessions with scholarship holders. Coaches will also be required to assist and participate in other NSW Player Development Programs.

All coaches approved by the NSW NITCP Head Coach will be required to sign a "Coaches Code of Conduct" agreement, and meet the requirements of the child protection act. Coaches are reminded that at all times they are under the direction of the NSW ITCP Head Coach and Basketball NSW.
