It is a condition of entry that all participating Associations **MUST** have a delegate in attendance at the NSW State Basketball League Meeting.

Associations **MUST** also show that they are financial members of Basketball NSW and have no outstanding accounts. Basketball NSW reserves the right to assess each Association's registration figures at the time of evaluating the 2010 Nominations.

Associations entering the State League must be incorporated and the Official Entry Form signed by the Association Secretary.

Associations are reminded that penalties are applicable for teams withdrawing from any BNSW competitions.

Penalties are as follows for the SBL competition:

1. After the Nomination Closing Date (6th February 2009) = Loss of Nomination Fee & Team Fee
2. After the release of the draw = Loss of Nomination Fee & Team Fee plus \$2000.00 fine
3. After the release of the draw and within two months of the commencement of the competition = Loss of Nomination Fee & Team Fee plus \$4000.00 fine.
4. After the commencement of competition = Loss of Nomination Fee & Team Fee plus \$5000.00 fine and the withdrawal of all associations teams competing in the SBL programs, this includes Youth League. (eg SBL Women withdraw the removal of SBL Men, Youth League Men and Women will occur).

Associations are asked to read the referee requirements and additional information section carefully. Please return required referee information as part of the official entry form.

Referee Requirements



State Basketball League

1 referees per team of level 2 standard or above. (1A level will be accepted at the BNSW/ SBL Commissioners' discretion)

Youth League

1 referees per team of level 1A standard or above. (1B/Y5 level will be accepted at the BNSW SBL Commissioners' discretion)

Additional Information



An association that nominates 1 or more teams in the SBL or YL divisions is required to nominate an association referee coordinator and referee coach (this may be the same person)

A referee's level refers to the current accreditation given to the individual by Basketball NSW.

A referee who is nominated by an association must have a primary registration with that association.

All nominated referees must attend the Referees Action Day Sunday 7th February at Bankstown Basketball Stadium (further information will be available on the BNSW website) and achieve passes in the theory and fitness tests for the association to meet requirements. There will be 3 regional mini-referee action days at Tamworth, Wagga and Bathurst. Tentative dates for these are 6th & 7th February dates to be confirmed.

Any referee can only appear once on the registration form and cannot be nominated for more than one team, or more than one association.

Failure to Meet Requirements

Those associations that fail to meet requirements will be individually contacted by BNSW Events & Referees Manager. Non completion of requirements for 2010 will result in the additional referee travel fee being charged per team (as indicated below).

New in 2010



Associations are required to complete a Team Registration Form for each team competing in a Waratah League. Associations are to keep the originals, with copies sent to BNSW. **THIS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH YOUR NOMINATION FORM.**

All Teams entered must be accompanied by a record of the Local Comp for that particular division at the home venue. Eg if you nominate an Waratah Men, then you must provide proof that your association runs a local comp for that age division. Suitable proof will be to provide a copy of the current Local Comp Draw along with an approximate estimate of # of players participating. Failure to provide such information will result in teams not being eligible to participate in the 2010 Waratah League Competition.

League Fees



Association Fee: \$1,460 GST not included

Team Fee: \$410 GST not included (per team)

Referee Travel: \$300.00 GST inc (per team)

Associations that are unable to supply their referee quota will be charged \$900.00 GST inc (per team) 2010

Referee Game Payments:

Youth League \$42.00 per referee for each home game

Division One Men & Women \$47 per referee for each home game

Eg 1: Newcastle Nominates

SBL Men and SBL Women sides - Charged $\$1,460 + \$820 + \$600 = \2880

Yth Men and Yth Women sides - Charged $\$1,460 + \$820 + \$600 = \2880

Plus Referee Game Payments

Eg 2: Newcastle Nominates

SBL Men side - Charged $\$1,460 + \$410 + \$300 = \2170

Yth Men and Yth Women sides - Charged $\$1,460 + \$820 + \$600 = \2880

Plus Referee Game Payments

Eg 3: Newcastle Nominates

SBL Men and SBL Women sides - Charged $\$1,460 + \$820 + \$600 = \2880

2 Yth Men sides and Yth Women side - Charged $\$1,460 + \$1230 + \$900 = \3590

Plus Referee Game Payments

Referees Fees:

Youth League - \$42.00

Division One & Women - \$47.00

Scoretable Fees:

\$12.00 for Scoretable.

SBL Payments:

1st Instalment - 31st March 2010

2nd Instalment - 31st May 2010

3rd Instalment - 31st July 2010

In the event that an association fails to pay an instalment the balance is required to be paid in full. If payment is not received withdrawal of all teams will be immediate.
